ABOUT THE CONTEST

Launched in 2022, the **Pierre Cardin Young Designers Award** is an international contest created for fashion students. The contest seeks the next generation of emerging design talent from around the world and offers an opportunity for students to hone their craft within the design studio of Maison Pierre Cardin under the direction of house president Rodrigo Cardin.

The Pierre Cardin Young Designers Award has already hosted past editions in a number of major cities around the world including Mexico City, New York, Rio de Janeiro, Sao Paulo, Shanghai, Guangzhou, Beijing, Tel Aviv, Taipei, Seoul and Paris ... establishing a direct relationship with design students to encourage their participation. For its **edition number 15**, the contest will focus on the **USA**, and **the winner will be chosen in Dallas on November 20**.

A pre-selection of students will be chosen during collective design **workshops organized between**

November 14th and 19th of 2025 in different cities: NYC, San Francisco and Dallas. The jury of the Pierre Cardin Young Designers Award will select **1 final winner** and he/she will be invited to enjoy a 3-month internship at the Pierre Cardin studio in Paris to develop their skills alongside the design team. The Contest Winner will also receive **housing** and a **meal stipend**, as well as an intern salary of 1000€ / month.

GENERAL CONDITIONS TO PARTICIPATE

This competition is aimed at students enrolled in fashion schools in USA aged 18 and over. The deadline for submitting an application is November 11, 2025. Beyond this deadline, no application will be considered.



Students may submit a menswear, womenswear, or children's wear sketch (3 drawings maximum). They should familiarize and inspire themselves with the futurist vision of Pierre Cardin as well as his use of geometric forms and propose innovative textiles and production methods, while bringing their own unique design perspective to their sketches.

> The following elements will be considered when selecting finalists:

- Creativity and originality
- Sketching skills
- Understanding of the Pierre Cardin brand identity
- Coherence with, and reinterpretation of the design codes of Maison Cardin
- Production techniques: Textiles and materials

- Proposition of a sustainable approach to design and production
- Portfolio design that elaborates on the creative concept

Students must also be prepared to define different sustainable and innovative production methods which seek to improve ecological and social conditions in the fashion industry and consider all aspects of presenting their work to the jury.

> Pierre Cardin Award is authorized to:

- Extend the deadline for the registration period or the submission of digital files.
- Change the date, location, and manner in which the winners will be announced.
- Modify the categories, rename them, merge them, or eliminate them.
- All competition communication will be conducted in English.

- Completed and signed registration form (first page)
- Sketches (pdf file, 3 sheets maximum)
- Student photo
- School certificate (preferred but not required)
- Portfolio (preferred but not required)

This information and documents will be used solely by the members of the jury to select the candidates invited to a workshop and may be used in communication concerning the winner at the end of the competition.
